Some Useful Tips on Waste Collection Day

- Please have your automated containers out to the **curb by 7:00 am** on your collection day (collection times vary).
- As per city ordinance, please do **not** allow your waste **containers to sit out** on the street longer than 24 hours before and after waste pick-up services.
- Please **bag all your garbage** to help prevent litter. Especially bag plastic grocery sacks, packing peanuts, and shredded paper. Please do not bag recycling and GreenWaste materials unless it is shredded paper.
- On pickup day, please make sure the front of your containers face the street. Keep your containers **3 to 4 feet apart** and away from other objects such as mailboxes, telephone poles, trees, and vehicles.
- Please **do not overfill your container**. Anything over 4 feet in length is too large for any of the containers. Please cut down large tree branches and boxes.
- Please **do not overload your containers** with bulky or heavy items such as bricks, construction materials, & appliances.
- Please **do not put hot ashes or coals** in your automated containers. If the containers melt you may be responsible for a replacement fee.
- Please **do not put anything hazardous, flammable or restricted** in your automated containers such as: oil, car batteries, paint, TVs, or any product that is corrosive, flammable, ignitable or reactive. Bring these types of materials to our Household Hazardous Waste Facility for FREE. Call **750-9981** for more details.

TIP OF THE SEASON:

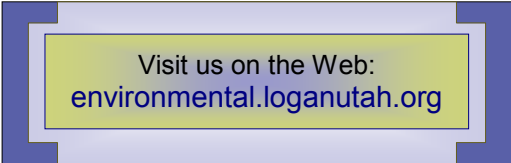
KEEP EM' CLOSED-Make sure your lids are securely down on your can to prevent stink in your black cans and contamination in your blue cans. If the lids do not close all the way, it means your can is over-filled, which can lead to

- **Do not put glass in your curbside blue bin** as it is not accepted in the blue cans. Glass is very dangerous to those that sort the materials. Please learn the types of materials for recycle.
- Please **do not put garbage next to your container** if it is full. If the materials are recyclable, the landfill has extra dumpsters to use free of charge; if not, regular landfill fees apply.
- Please **learn what types of materials go in what bin**. Call in or check out our website.
- Please **use your community GreenWaste bins** or the weekly GreenWaste curbside service. This really helps decrease the amount of waste ending up in the landfill.

Waste Collection services & the Logan Landfill and all its operations will be closed on:

- January 1

*Note that on holidays, there is no residential pick-up. Place your cans out the next day for collection unless the holiday falls on a Friday, make-up days are the following Monday unless otherwise specified.

Litter takes the serene out of serenity

Please do your part to keep Cache County Clean by observing these simple tips:

- 1) Just don't litter.
- 2) If you have a truck, do not put lightweight materials in the bed as they are susceptible to blow out.
- 3) Cover your loads going in and out of landfill.
- 4) Secure all loads in transportation of any materials.
- 5) Do not overfill trash receptacles i.e., the lids must securely close.
- 6) Do not overfill recycle receptacles i.e., the lids must securely close.
- 7) Bag all of your loose garbage.
- 8) Bag shredded paper for recycling
- 9) Make sure your curbside automated containers are at least 4 feet apart.

Recycling decreases garbage. Decreased garbage means less money spent on pick-up and/or size of receptacle. Recycling is cheaper than garbage collection.

- Cardboard dumpster = FREE
- Paper dumpster = FREE
- Ferrous Metal dumpster = FREE
- Blue can = \$3/ month
- 24 yard Mixed Recycle Dumpster = \$24/month
