

Rules & Regulations for the Insulation Incentive

Qualifications:

- Home must have an all-electric heating system.
- Incentive is for **attic insulation ONLY**.
- Pre-existing insulation must be an R-19 or lower to be eligible for the rebate.
- Insulation must be installed in a pre-existing home. New home construction, remodeling jobs, additions, etc are not eligible for this rebate.
- Insulation installed over unheated spaces, such as a garage or patio, do not qualify for incentives.
- Customer must insulate to an R-49 or greater to receive this incentive. If only a portion of an attic can be insulated to this level, a customer must show a separate invoice or separate line item on the invoice which reflect the insulation and labor that is eligible for this incentive.
- Insulation can be installed by a contractor or a customer. Self-installers cannot charge for labor – incentive will be on materials only. To ensure that your insulation is installed correctly and to gain the most benefit from the retrofit, we recommend using a contractor.

If self installing: IMPORTANT! If you self-install you must arrange for two inspections from Logan City Environmental Department; one to check the R-value **BEFORE YOU INSTALL** and one **POST INSTALLATION**. ***Incentives will not be paid to self-installers who do not schedule these inspections.*** Please check your pre-existing R-value (or measure the depth and type of existing insulation) **BEFORE** your inspection and have it available for this application. Please call 716-9792 to schedule an inspection.

- Maximum payment not to exceed 80% of customer cost.
- Do not apply for your incentive until insulation has been installed.

Application Details: Please mail/drop off completed applications, along with a contractors invoice AND proof of payment (a cancelled check, credit card receipt, portion of a bank statement) at City of Logan, Environmental Department, 450 N 1000 W Logan, UT 84321 Attn: **Be Energy Wise Program**. Applications must be filled out completely. Incomplete applications will result in a delayed or denied incentive.

Contractor invoices must clearly indicate square footage for each area, insulation type, R-values for insulation installed, R-Values for insulation pre-installation, and cost of materials and labor before sales tax. Invoices must be specific for installations that are eligible for this rebate or be a separate line item. Invoices must be dated with the date of installation.

Incentive Availability: All incentives are subject to available funds. Incentives will be serviced on a first-come, first-served basis according to postmark. Program start is February 1, 2009. Customer has 90 days from the installation to file this application. This incentive program is subject to change and/or modification at any time, for any reason. This incentive is not a guarantee of workmanship or energy savings.

Eligible Customers: Any Logan City Light and Power residential customer who utilizes electric heat for their total space heating needs is eligible for the insulation rebate.

Timeframe: Please allow 8-10 weeks for your rebate to be posted to your utility account.
