Forcible Sodomy

At approximately 11:25 PM on January 20, 2012 Logan Police officers were dispatched to 1225 West 200 North on a report of an intoxicated male refusing to leave a residence. Upon arrival, officers investigated the incident and took custody of the intoxicated man. While enroute to the Cache County Jail, the intoxicated male passed out in the police vehicle. The officer attempted to wake the suspect but was unsuccessful. The officer called for EMS and an ambulance to respond. Logan City paramedics arrived, evaluated and ultimately transported the unconscious man to Logan Regional Hospital. Once at the hospital, the emergency staff was unable to wake the male subject as well. The male subject was put in an exam room and the emergency room staff was overseeing his care.

The officer stationed himself outside the door of the intoxicated male and wrote his report outlining the incident of trespass, public urination, and public intoxication.

Once done with his report, the officer decided to check on the subject. In doing so, the officer walked in the room and pulled the curtain back slightly. The officer observed the unconscious man laying on the hospital bed and the male caregiver performing a sexual act on the patient. The officer summoned hospital security notifying the hospital of what he observed. The caregiver, later identified as Hal L. Weston (46) of Laketown, Utah was later interviewed by detectives and ultimately arrested and incarcerated on charges of forcible sodomy.

The investigation is ongoing.
