- 5. Weekly updates to the website information provided to the city for the next week of closures, etc.
- 6. Yes, through Chuck Shaw. We will coordinate through him for all social media posts.
- 7. Scoring will cover as main factors, but is not limited to, Cost, Key Personnel and Approach.
- 8. The schedule will have changes to the dates because of some change in individual project scheduling that has happened.
- 9. Chip Seal happens in July, there will be other events throughout the city, County Fair, Tour of Utah.
- 10. There will be a weekly meeting for each individual project, the locations may vary from City Hall to onsite meetings.
- 11. A personal relationship with the public affected by the projects, be able to adapt to the changes in schedule, stay a week or so ahead of the project making sure people are informed of closures happening in advance.
- 12. 400 North Medians project has been canceled for this year due to cost of overall project.
