FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the purpose of Business Licensing?

To oversee the regulation and licensure of businesses within Logan, to maintain a current index of licensed businesses, and to raise revenue necessary to regulate licensed entities.

Do I require a Logan business license?

It is unlawful for any person, either directly or indirectly, to engage in business or conduct any nonprofit enterprise, or to use in connection therewith any vehicle, premises, machine or device, in whole or in part, within the city for which a license is required without first procuring a license.

Are there exemptions to the requirement to license?

- 1. A home occupation with gross receipts of less than \$1,200.00 per year does not require a business license, but registration with the Division of Business Licensing is recommended.
- 2. The provisions of this chapter (Title 5 of the Municipal Code) shall not be deemed or construed to require the payment of a license fee by, or the issuance of a license to any institution or organization which is conducted, managed or carried on wholly for the benefit of charitable purposes or from which profit is not derived, directly or indirectly by any individual, firm or profit corporation. Organizers, managers or owners of such exempt event or organization must register with the Business License Division.

What inspections and/or reviews are required?

<u>All</u> applications are subject to a review process. Decisions on business license applications take 15 business days (minimum). However, the business preparation and availability for relevant commercial inspections can accelerate or lengthen the time frame.

Based on the application, city departments carry-out reviews and inspections that ensure the business is in compliance with fire, building, environmental, and other public safety interests, and zoning laws prior to opening.

What is the review and inspection criteria?

The best source of information is the City of Logan publication, *You've Made Application for a Business License - Now What?*. It is found on the Business Licensing page at www.loganutah.org, or at Logan City Hall at 290 North 100 West.

What happens if I operate a business without a license?

No business operations may commence or continue without a valid business license. Every day an unlicensed business operates shall be considered a separate offense subject to a Class B Misdemeanor citation issued by the Logan City Police Department.

Incomplete applications cannot be accepted.

Application Requirements

A valid application includes:

- the completed form, found at loganutah.org
- the applicable fee
- any additional materials prescribed for certain business types; including, but not limited to, transient merchants, sidewalk vendors, special event organizers, solicitors, and businesses selling alcohol

Logan Police Background Checks

The application process includes a Logan Police background check for each business principal and local manager.

Fee waiver for Non-Profit Corporations

The City of Logan will waive business license fees for registered non-profit corporations. Proof of status is required to be provided at the time of application by presenting a 501(c)(3) letter.

Partial year fees

Prorations for partial year licensing occur on December 1st for licenses under fee codes: C-1, C-2, M-1, ALC, or Home Occupations. See Logan Business Licensing staff for details.
