Acceptable Construction Debris (C&D):

Bricks, Rocks, Concrete, Asphalt, Fencing, PVC Piping, Roofing Shingles, Tree Root Balls & Sheet Rock.
As a general rule, if it can blow away, it is not accepted in the C&D area.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

The Logan Landfill is a municipal Solid Waste Facility with a household hazardous waste exclusion program. Household hazardous are items such as used oil, paint, pesticides, antifreeze, car batteries, TVs, or any product with the words Caution, Warning, or Poison on the label. There is no additional charge for the disposal of these materials at the household hazardous waste center located at the Logan Landfill, however there is a limit of 5 gal. per day per customer. Please call the landfill with questions or for more information.

COLLECTION FAQ's

What time should my cans be to the curb for collection?

All containers should be set out for collection by 7:00 AM on your collection day. Cans should be placed with the front of the container facing the street. As per city ordinance, please do not allow your waste containers to sit out on the street longer than 24 hours before and after waste collection services.

How much space should be between my cans and other objects?

Place cans 3 to 4 feet away from other containers, mail boxes, cars, snow banks, etc. and in a straight line with the other containers along the street. Please do not place near mail boxes, telephone poles, or behind other containers and DO NOT place under overhead wires or trees.

What if I have extra garbage?

Make sure all your refuse is placed inside your containers for pickup. If you have extra, please call our office to determine how we can best assist you.

How can I best prevent litter?

Bagging your loose items (especially plastic bags and packing peanuts) as well as your garbage will keep your containers clean and will help prevent litter. You may bag shredded papers or loose papers that will be placed in your recycling container, however no other items should be bagged in the recycling bin.. Please DO NOT overfill or overload your container; since drivers are not required to pick up spilled garbage from an overloaded container.

What is not allowed in my cans?

Please DO NOT place tires, dirt, or any large or bulky items over 4 ft. in length in containers. We also DO NOT allow any hazardous, flammable, or restricted materials in containers such as: hot ashes, oil, coal, gasoline, paint, pesticides, TV's, cleaning products, automobile batteries, etc. These items can be brought to our Household Hazardous Waste facility for FREE. Green cans are for green waste materials only. No rocks, dirt, or garbage are allowed in the green cans. Blue cans are for recyclable materials only. Do not put glass, garbage, plastic bags, clothing, or green waste in your blue curbside recycling container.

Can glass be placed in the blue recycling container?

The answer is no. Glass is very dangerous to those that sort materials and can render materials un-recyclable. We do offer 8 glass drop sites throughout Cache County. These locations can be found on our website or by calling our office. Please take a moment to learn which items can be placed in your blue recycling can.

RECYCLING

Cache County Service Area has a county wide curbside recycling program. Every home within Cache County should have a 90 gallon blue recycling container or blue mixed recycling dumpster. Blue recycling containers are collected at the curb every other week on your regular garbage collection day. A copy of the recycling collection calendar can be found on our website.

Materials ACCEPTED in our curbside recycling program include:

(place all items loose in the container)

Cardboard/Paperboard

Newspaper, Mixed Paper, Magazines, Catalogs, and paper of all types
(Please bag shredded or loose paper)

Metals

(such as aluminum cans & Tin/Steel Cans)

Any Plastic Container Numbered 1 - 7
(Please rinse containers and remove the lids)

Cell Phones

(Please place in zip lock bags)

Materials NOT ACCEPTED in our curbside recycling program include:

Glass bottles, plastic bags (even if they have the recycling symbol), soiled pizza boxes, plastic containers without the recycling symbol, garbage, hazardous waste, Styrofoam (even if it has a recycling symbol), clothing, rubber tires, or containers that once held motor oil.

Please cut down large boxes; all items must fit into the blue 90 gallon recycling container.

Please keep recycling container lids closed, especially during periods of wet or snowy weather.

Please call if you are unsure about what can go in your curbside recycling container.

For self hauling recycling materials, we have glass bins located throughout the county. We also have mixed recycling bins, ferrous metal bins, the landfill mall, and reuse shed located at the Logan City Environmental Center Campus. Please call or see our website for more information about these bins or services.

GREEN WASTE

Curbside green waste collection is available in select cities for a fee of \$4.00 per month (minimum 1 year commitment). This can is collected weekly, on your garbage day, generally from the last full week of March until the third week of November. To request a green can, please call our office.

Drop sites are available in select cities outside of Logan. Please check our website for locations near you.

Please do not overload curbside or drop site containers.

The **Green Waste Facility** is operated at the Logan City Environmental Center Campus and is open from 8 am to 5:30 pm Monday through Saturday.

Green Waste Materials Accepted:

Grass

Leaves

Hay & Straw

Branches

Shrubs

Garden Waste

Please NO rocks, dirt, gravel, sod, root balls, treated wood, plastic, garbage, or anything greater than 6 feet in length or 3 inches in diameter.

Please empty all bags or containers when self hauling and do not use bags or containers at drop site locations or in curbside cans.
