

2011 Logan City Municipal Elections

The City of Logan will hold its municipal election this fall to elect three council members. The Primary Election date is Tuesday, September 13, 2011; the General Election date is Tuesday, Tuesday, November 8, 2011. Logan elections are non-partisan.

Municipal council members serve four-year terms. Council candidates are elected at-large. The incumbents are:

Council Seat	Laraine Swenson
Council Seat	Jay Monson
Council Seat	Herm Olsen

Anyone interested in filing for one of these offices must:

- Be a U.S. citizen at time of filing
- Be a registered voter of Logan City
- Be at least 18 years old
- Be a resident of Logan City for at least 365 consecutive days immediately preceding the date of election (November 8, 2011)
- Not be a convicted felon

Each person seeking to become a candidate for a municipal office shall file a Declaration of Candidacy in person with the Logan City Recorder, 290 North 100 West, Logan, Utah, during office hours and not later than 5:00 p.m. from July 1 through July 15, 2011 (Note: City Hall and the Recorder's Office will be closed on Monday, July 4, 2011 in observance of Independence Day). The appropriate filing form is available at the City Recorder's Office. There is no filing fee.

Time: 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Location: Logan City Hall – 290 North 100 West (Recorder's Office)

Early Voting / Primary Election: Tues. Aug. 30 through Fri. Sept. 9, 2011

Municipal Election (if needed): Tuesday, September 13, 2011

Early Voting / General Election: Tues. Oct. 25 through Fri. Nov. 4, 2011

Municipal General Election: Tuesday, November 8, 2011
