### **Re: A Reminder to Dog Owners: Mt. Logan Park Walkways**

Logan Parks and Recreation Department would like to remind dog owners to clean up after their dogs at Hyrum Gibbons Mt. Logan Park. Dogs are allowed, on a trial basis, on leash on the walkways only that run through the park. Dogs are not allowed anywhere else in the park.

It has been reported to City staff that some dog owners are not cleaning up after their dogs. Dog owners must clean up any and all dog feces left by their dogs per ordinance 6.04.090. Clean up bags are available at doggie stations near the entrance of the park.

#### 6.04.090: ANIMAL WASTE; REMOVAL REQUIRED:

A. The owner or any person having control over or charge of any dog or other animal shall be responsible for the removal of any feces deposited by such dog or animal in any public place, including, but not limited to, sidewalks, streets, planting strips, parking lots, parks, recreational areas or on private property not in the ownership or control of the person having control or purporting to have control over or charge of such dog or animal.

B. Any person violating the foregoing subsection shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be subject to a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50) for each violation.

C. The sentencing judge may require that the offender devote up to four hours in cleaning up feces from any public park or other area designated by the sentencing judge. relinquished.
