Logan Parks and Recreation Department Master Plan Update Draft

The City of Logan Parks and Recreation Department announces the release of the draft version of the 2005-06 Master Plan Update to the public for review before final preparations to present the document to the Logan Municipal Council on April 18. The public review period extends to 5:00 p.m., Friday, April 7.

The Master Plan Update is intended to provide guidance into the future for the City in addressing parks and recreation issues and needs. The draft document contains an executive summary that speaks to the vision for the City's parks and recreation, changes and challenges facing the City, community-supported solutions, prioritization of needs as projects, programs, and policies, costs, and funding.

The 67-page draft contains an introduction of the plan update, goals and objectives for the City's parks and recreation, an analysis of population, current supply, an analysis of demand, goals and recommendations, cost and funding, an action plan time line, supplementary information including survey results, statistics, workshop comments, focus group summaries, citizen board input, and City parks and recreation information.

The 2005-06 Parks and Recreation Master Plan Update draft is available on the City of Logan web site at www.loganutah.org/parksrec and click onto Parks, Recreation, Trails, and Open Space Master Plan Update to view the document. Limited hard-bound copies of the Master Plan are also available for viewing at the Logan Recreation Center, 195 S. 100 West, Logan, and at the Logan Library, 255 N. Main Street, Logan.
