Public Information regarding the City of Logan
Tobacco and Smoke Free Zone Ordinance

A new ordinance prohibiting tobacco and smoking from the premises of the Logan Aquatic Center, Logan Skate Park, and Fairview Park was approved by the City of Logan on February 15, 2005. The Logan Aquatic Center, Logan Skate Park, and Fairview Park facilities are located on the same block bounded by 400 South, 500 West, 500 South, and the Union Pacific Railroad track.

The purpose of the ordinance is to protect against the harmful effects caused by tobacco, smoking, and second-hand smoke and to sustain quality of life, health, and well-being of patrons at these facilities. The ordinance will also aid department personnel in eliminating litter caused by improperly discarded cigarette butts and containers while reducing associated maintenance costs.

The affected area of the new tobacco and smoke-free zone ordinance refers to all public property including parking lots, sidewalks, amenities, and facilities from the property line of the Union Pacific Railroad track and 400 South to the northeast corner of 400 South and 500 West, to the southeast corner of 500 West and 500 South, to the southwest corner of 500 South and the property line of the Union Pacific Railroad track and 400 South.

Any person failing to comply with the tobacco and smoke-free zone ordinance is guilty of an infraction and subject to citation. The Logan Police Department will enforce the ordinance. The tobacco and smoke-free zone is maintained by the Logan Parks and Recreation Department.
