TO THE LOGAN CITY TRAIL SYSTEM

The City of Logan welcomes you to explore the Logan City Urban Trail System which includes boardwalks, 10' concrete trails, traditional side-walks, and gravel trails.

These trails provide an opportunity for fitness and fresh air in a safe environment so GET UP, GET OUT and GO!

- 1- **Bonneville Shoreline Trail**
Hard packed gravel surface. Wildlife and valley views.
- 2- **Boulevard Trail**
Scheduled for completion in Fall of 2008.
- 3- **Deer Fence Trail**
Hard packed gravel surface. Trail continues south to Providence Canyon
- 4- **ICON Trail**
Concrete trail. Wildlife.
- 5- **Logan River Walk Trail**
Concrete and asphalt trail. Wildlife and lots of shade.
- 6- **Mt. Logan Park Walkway**
Concrete trail loops around the park. Valley Views.
- 7- **Pioneer Park Walkway**
Concrete trail runs through Pioneer Park and Merlin Olsen Central Park
- 8- **Soccer Park Walkway**
Asphalt trail loops around the park. Wildlife.
- 9- **Stewart Nature Park Trail**
Concrete trail loops around the park. Native plants and wildlife.
- 10- **Westside Trail**
Concrete and asphalt trail ranging from 10' to 5' width. Trail runs through mainly residential neighborhoods.

- 1- **Planet Interpretive Tour**
Planet markers placed along the Logan River Walk Trail.
- 2- **Wildlife and Plant Interpretive Tour**
Interpretive signs are placed along the Stewart Nature Park Trail.

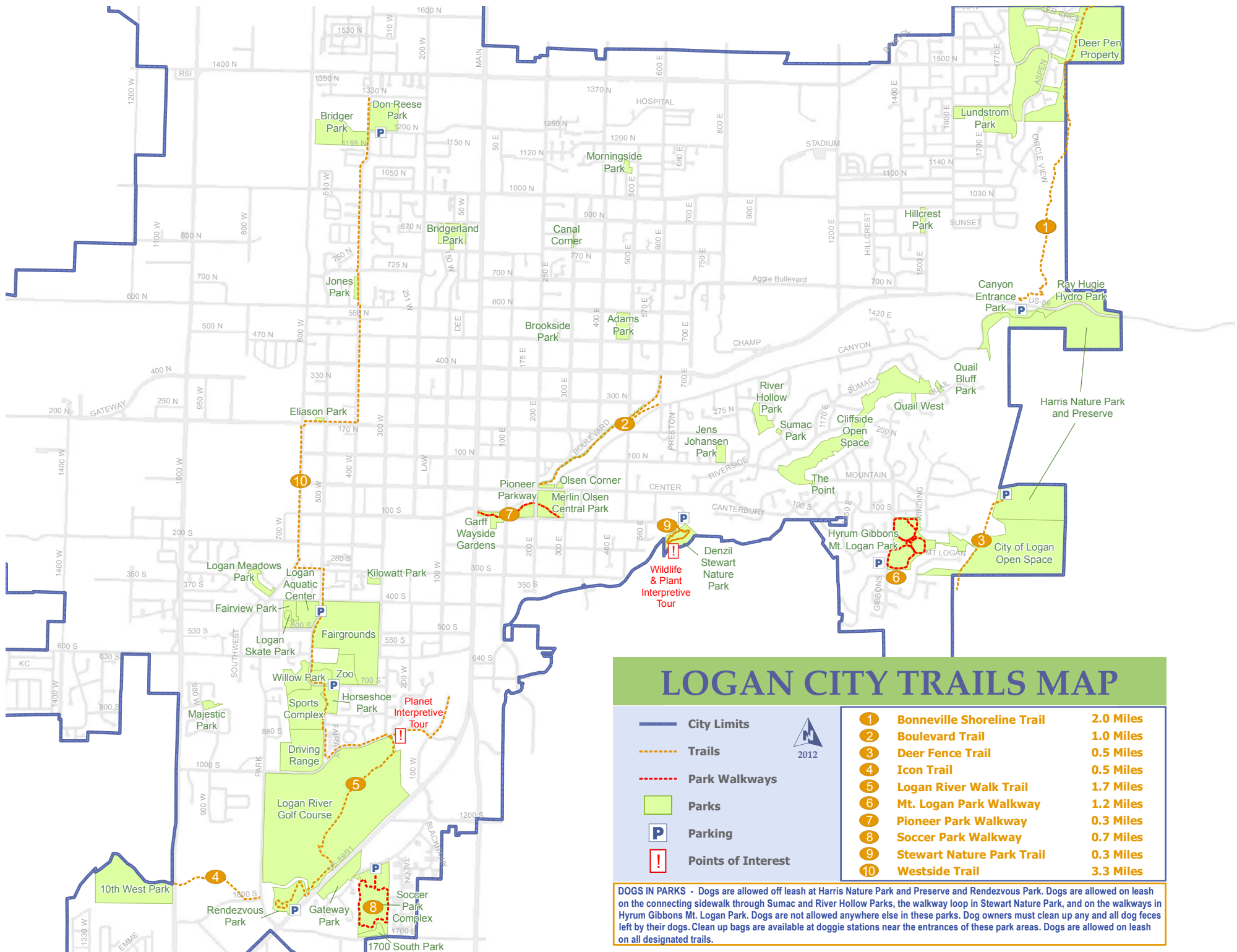

DOGS IN PARKS - Dogs are allowed off leash at Harris Nature Park and Preserve and Rendezvous Park. Dogs are allowed on leash on the connecting sidewalk through Sumac and River Hollow Parks, the walkway loop in Stewart Nature Park, and on the walkways in Hyrum Gibbons Mt. Logan Park. Dogs are not allowed anywhere else in these parks. Dog owners must clean up any and all dog feces left by their dogs. Clean up bags are available at doggie stations near the entrances of these park areas. Dogs are allowed on leash on all designated trails.
