



2019 NOTICE OF ELECTION CITY OF LOGAN, UTAH

The City of Logan will hold its municipal election this fall to elect three council members. The Primary Election date is Tuesday, August 13, 2019 and the General Election date is Tuesday, November 5, 2019. Logan elections are non-partisan.

Municipal council members serve four-year terms and are elected at-large.

The incumbents are:

Council Seat	Tom Jensen
Council Seat	Herm Olsen
Council Seat	Jeannie F. Simmonds

Anyone interested in filing for one of these offices must:

- Be a U.S. citizen at time of filing
- Be a registered voter of Logan City
- Be at least 18 years old
- Be a resident of Logan City for at least 365 consecutive days immediately preceding the date of election (November 5, 2019)
- Not be a convicted felon

Each person seeking to become a candidate for a municipal office shall file a Declaration of Candidacy in person with the Logan City Recorder, 290 North 100 West, Logan, Utah, during office hours and not later than 5:00 p.m. from June 3, 2019 through June 7, 2019. The appropriate filing form is available at the City Recorder's Office. There is no filing fee.

Location: Logan City Hall – 290 North 100 West (Recorder's Office)

Municipal Primary Election (if needed): Tuesday, August 13, 2019

Municipal General Election: Tuesday, November 5, 2019
